ABOUT PPA and its importance

The Provincial Product Accounts (PPA):




aims to present a comprehensive picture of the provincial economies by providing a more appropriate measure and assessment of a province's economic performance;

will serve as an important tool in economic planning and policy formulation at the sub regional levels to supplement the GDP at the national and regional levels;



viewed as a means to strengthen the planning, and decision-making of provincial policymakers and other stakeholders;

monitor the economic development at the local level and assess the progress through time, e.g PDPs, SDGs

THE VISION OF PPA

By 2025, to institutionalize:



GROSS DOMESTIC PRODUCT (GDP)

is the monetary value of all final goods and services produced within the economy in a given period of time

MEASUREMENT OF GDP (Production Approach)

GDP = Sum of Gross Value Added (GVA) of all industries

GVA = Gross Output (GO) – Intermediate Consumption (IC)

INDUSTRIES IN THE PPA

The compilation of PPA follows the same framework work as the internationally recognized 2008 System of National Accounts (SNA) used in the regional and national compilation of GDP.

Industries covered are also aligned with the 2009 Philippine Standard Industrial Classification (PSIC). These industries are:

AGRICULTURE, FORESTRY, AND FISHING INDUSTRY

- Mining and quarrying
- Manufacturing
- Electricity, steam, water and waste management
- Construction

SERVICES

- Wholesale and retail trade; repair of motor vehicles and motorcycles
- Transportation and storage
- Accommodation and food service activities
- Information and communication
- Financial and insurance activities
- Real estate and ownership of dwellings
- Professional and business services
- Public administration and defense; compulsory social activities
- Education
- Human health and social work activities
- Other services

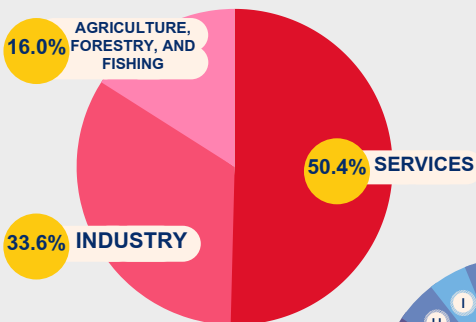

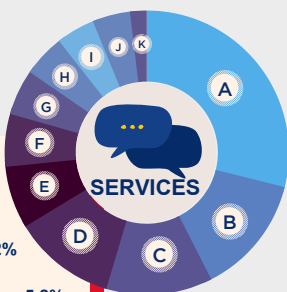

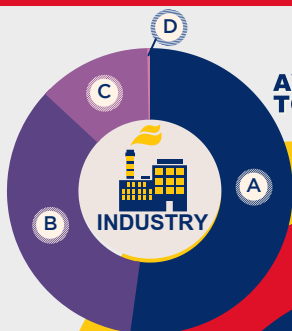
Three-Year Average Share of Major Industries to the Economy: Oriental Mindoro
